1. further to our conversation last thursday i have now received firm instructions and would request that you contact mr. velthuisen personally and instruct him as follows:-
 - (a) to arrange immediate official translation of the patent application and other relevant documents (if any) into english and to forward certified copies under appropriate secure cover to me in perth and to our london office (attention mr. t. davy or mr. d. stow). we may ask mr. v. to send further copies to other persons in due course.
 - (b) notwithstanding earlier instructions, to prepare corresponding patent applications for filing in u.k., italy, france, sweden and canada. further countries may follow.

2. would you please explain to mr. v. the thinking which has prompted these decisions and advise him that i am arranging telegraphic transfer of approx. five thousand four hundred guilders to his firm's account at bank mees + hope in payment of his outstanding accounts. v. has already advised that additional applications will be approx. three thousand guilders for each country and i will arrange transfer of further funds as he requires them.

3. for your information only - i am also taking steps to instruct an attorney in washington d.c. so that he will be in a position to head off any trouble which might arise in usa. john thanks you for your information on engineers and has already taken "protective measures". he suggests that you still aim to come early june but will be in touch with you soon to confirm arrangements.

4. i will telex mr. v. today as follows:-

"1. i have asked mr. peter van oosanen to contact you with further instructions relating to :-

(a) translation of patent application into english,

(b) filing of patent applications in other countries.

mr. van oossanen will be able to explain these instructions and you are authorised to act at his request.

2. i have arranged telegraphic transfer to your firm's accountant/bank nees + hope of approx. five thousand four hundred guilders in payment of outstanding balance on your invoice numbers 002291 and 03303 and will provide further funds as required. i apologise for late payment of these accounts."

5. please let me know if any of the above is not clear.

i will look forward to seeing you next month.
